Context

The 30th UN Climate Change Conference (COP30), hosted in Belém, will focus on expanding climate financing and reviewing the new targets of the Paris Agreement. One of the key priorities of the Brazilian presidency will be forest restoration, highlighted as the fastest and most effective strategy for carbon capture.

COP30 will take place from November 10 to 21, 2025, in Belém (Pará), with official activities at the City Park and the Hangar – Convention & Exhibition Centre. The Leaders' Summit is scheduled for November 6–7.

During COP30 (Belém) — Daily war room, media management, support for side events, institutional coordination, and bilateral meeting management.

Post-COP (up to 30 days)— Executive report, media monitoring, KPI assessment, follow-up strategy, and roadmap for next steps.
